


Nlab - Nevada lubelskie acceleration bridge







The Lubelskie voivodeship is one of the most buoyant regions in Eastern Poland. It is a strong, academic, cultural, and economic region conveniently connected with the rest of the country, located in close proximity to the eastern border of the European Union.









Access to infrastructure



- Good access to infrastructure, namely the access to the Pan-European
 east-west/north-south transit corridor.
- A major investment for the region was Lublin Airport which opened at the end of 2012 and is one of the most modern airports in Poland







- 14% of the fruit and vegetables in Poland originate from the Lubelskie Region
- 71% of the Lubelskie Voivodeship is made up of agricultural land
- The Lubelskie Region is one of Poland's leading producers of cereals, including especially wheat, oat and barley
- Good climatic conditions and fertile soils
- The industry has over 1 500 enterprises and a workforce of almost 20 000.
